RE: VALIDATION RESULT OF THE 2017
PERFORMANCE SCORECARD OF SRA

Dear Sec. Piñol and Admin. Serafica,

This is to formally transmit the validation result of SRA's 2017 Performance Scorecard. Based on the Governance Commission's validation of documentary submissions and conduct of on-site validation on 16 July 2018, SRA gained an over-all score of **79.58%** (See *Annex A*). The same is to be posted in SRA's website, in accordance with Section 43 of GCG Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 2012-07.

In relation to its application for the grant of the 2017 PBB to eligible officers and employees, the SRA fails to satisfy the requirements of GCG M.C. No. 2017-01 and the Checklist of Documents to be submitted by GOCCs to Qualify for the FY 2017 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB), particularly the achievement of a weighted-average score of at least 90% in its 2017 Performance Scorecard. In this regard, the Board is reminded that any unilateral action to release the PBB will be considered as a violation of the Board's fiduciary duty to protect the assets of the GOCC as provided under Section 19 of Republic Act No. 10149.1

Consequently, pursuant to GCG M.C. No. 2016-01, failure to qualify for the PBB means that the Appointive Members of the Governing Board of SRA shall not be qualified to receive the Performance-Based Incentive (PBI).
