

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR No. _ O

TO : ALL SRA OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

RE : Liquidation of Cash Advances

This is to reiterate the rules and regulations on the grant and liquidation of Cash Advances under Section 4 of the COA Circular No. 97-002, which became a subject of the COA Audited Observation Memorandum No. 2017-04 dated 27 April 2017 issued to the Sugar Regulatory Administration. A copy of the COA Circular No. 97-002 is attached hereto, for your reference.

Section 4 of the COA Circular No. 97-002 states, among others that:

- 1. No additional cash advances shall be allowed to any official or employee unless the previous cash advance given to him is first settled or a proper accounting thereof is made.
- 2. A cash advance shall be reported on as soon as the purpose for which it was given has been served.
- 3. Only permanently appointed officials shall be designated as disbursing officers.
- 4. Only duly appointed or designated disbursing officers may perform disbursing functions. Officers and employees who are given cash advances for official travel need not be designated as Disbursing Officers.
- 5. Transfer of cash advance from one Accountable Officer (AO) to another shall not be allowed.
- 6. The grant of cash advance for both official local and foreign travel shall be governed by the provisions of COA Circular No. 96-004 dated April 19, 1996.

Please review and carefully study the COA Circular No. 97-002 to avoid any irregularity on the grant and liquidation of cash advances.
