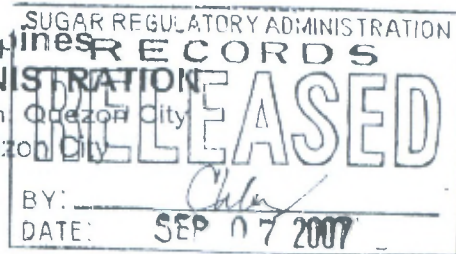

**SUGAR ORDER NO. 2**  
Series of 2007-2008

**SUBJECT: QUEDANNING OF "C" OR RESERVE SUGAR  
AND "D" OR WORLD MARKET SUGAR**

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 of Sugar Order No. 1, Series of 2007-2008 dated 06 September 2007 stated that a "Sugar Order shall be issued to further define the rules and regulations in the consolidated "blocked" quedanning of "C" (Reserve) and "D" (World Market) sugar."

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the powers vested in the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA), it is hereby ordered that:

**Section 1. Quedanning of "C" or Reserve sugar.** The "B" or Domestic sugar quedan-permit forms for Crop Year 2007-2008 shall be used to cover every week-ending's production of "C" or Reserve sugar and shall be issued after the said "B" sugar quedan-permits have been properly stamped as "C" or Reserve Sugar and validated by the SRA Regulation Officers (ROs) assigned at the millsites.

**Section 2. Quedanning of "D" or World Market Sugar.** The quedanning of the "D" or World Market sugar production shall be done using the "A" or U.S. Quota sugar quedan-permit forms of CY 2007-2008 after the said "A" quedan-permits have been properly stamped as "D" and validated by the SRA Regulation Officers (ROs) assigned at the millsites.

**Section 3. Block Quedanning of "C" (Reserved) and "D" (World Market) sugar quedans.** Mill companies shall, on a weekly basis, issue consolidated (block quedanning) "C" quedans and "D" quedan permits (separately) to planters (planter's share) in the name of the planters' association/cooperative as assignee, attached thereto the list of planters by planters' association/cooperative and their corresponding volume of "C" sugar or "D" sugar as the case may be.

Sugar Planters who wish to be "independent", i.e. to have their quedans issued individually, shall inform the Mill in writing, and the Mill shall accommodate the same and submit a report to the SRA.

**Section 4. Availability of the "D" or World Market Sugar to Sugar-Based Food Manufacturers/Exporters.** The "D" sugar may be made available to the sugar-based food processors/exporters chargeable to their 2008 import allocations.


**Section 5. Refining of the "D" sugar.** Only actual exporters/shippers of Philippine sugar to the World Market, or Sugar-Based Food Manufacturers/Exporters with approved sugar allocations for the current crop year, shall be allowed refining of the "D" sugar.

The refinery shall require the party tolling the "D" sugar to secure approval of the SRA for refining of the same.

**Section 6. Effectivity** – This order shall take effect immediately.

**Section 7. Repealing Clause** – All provisions of Sugar Orders, Circular Letters, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to this Sugar Order are hereby amended, modified or revoked accordingly.
