**SUGAR ORDER NO.** 5  
Series of 2006-2007

**SUBJECT : PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CERTIFICATE OF EXCHANGE AUTHORITY (CEA) DUE TO CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, the present rules and regulations on exchange ("swapping") of two (2) classes of sugar quedan-permits do not provide for amendments of the Certificate of Exchange Authority (CEA) issued by the SRA due to change of ownership;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA), it is hereby ordered:

**Section 1.** A sugar trader/exporter requesting for amendment of the CEA issued by the SRA due to change of ownership shall re-apply with the SRA, attached thereto the Deed of Sale, affidavit of ownership, original CEA and shall pay the SRA an amendment fee of Three Pesos (PHP3.00) per Lkg-bag of sugar.

**Section 2.** This Sugar Order shall take effect immediately.

**Section 3.** Provisions of Sugar Orders, Circular Letters, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to this Sugar order are hereby revoked, amended or modified accordingly.
