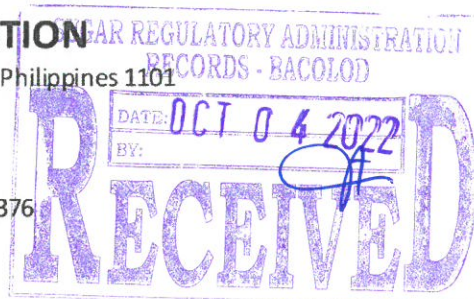

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SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 1

**Supply and Delivery of One (1) unit 90Hp Tractor with farm implements
2022-SIDA-06**

With reference to the Bidding Documents for the Supply and Delivery of One (1) unit 90Hp Tractor with farm implements, posted at the PhilGEPS and SRA websites, this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is being issued to clarify, amend, modify some items in the provisions of the Bidding Documents in response to the recommendations raised by prospective bidders, as follows:
